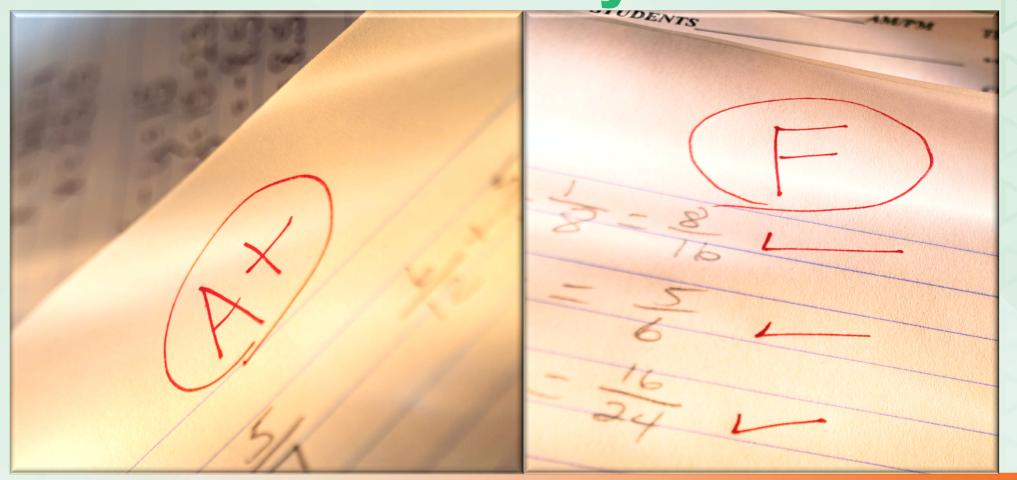

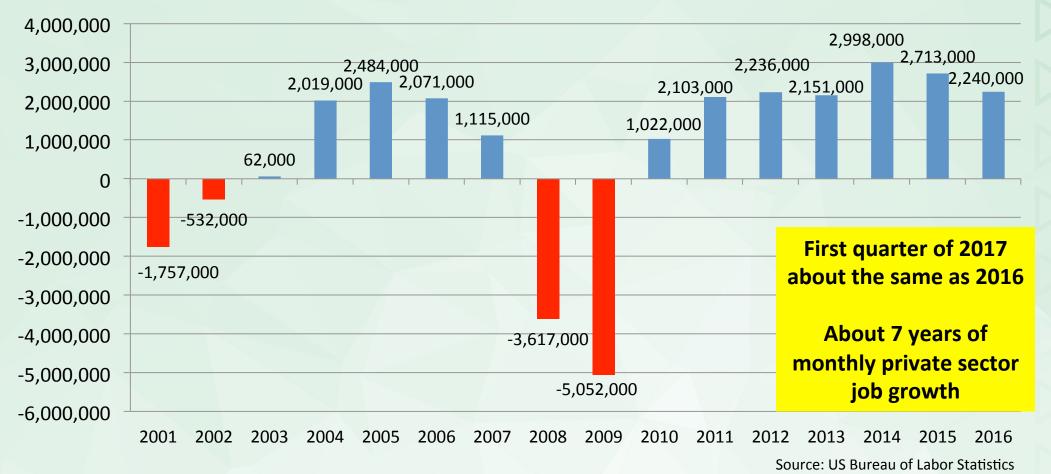




## **Annual U.S. Nonfarm Employment Change**







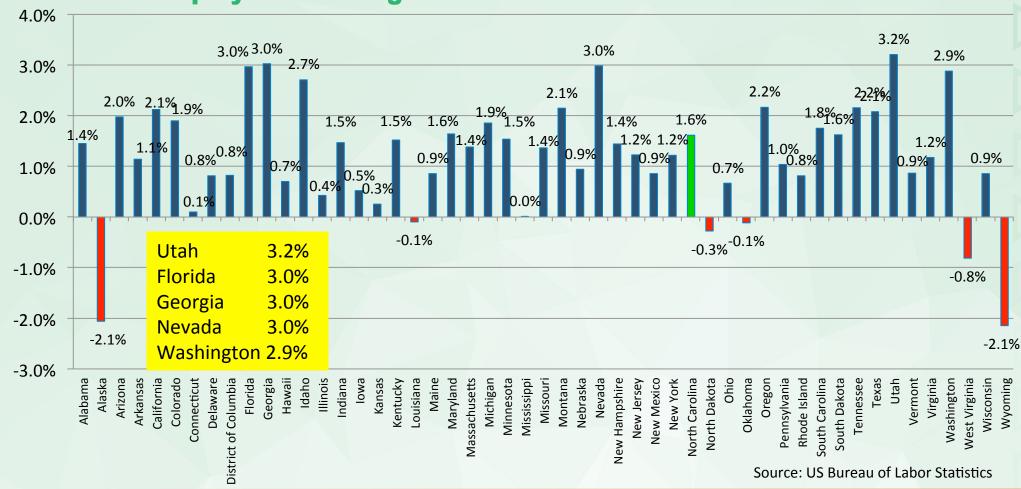

## % Nonfarm Employment Change Mar 2016 - Mar 2017







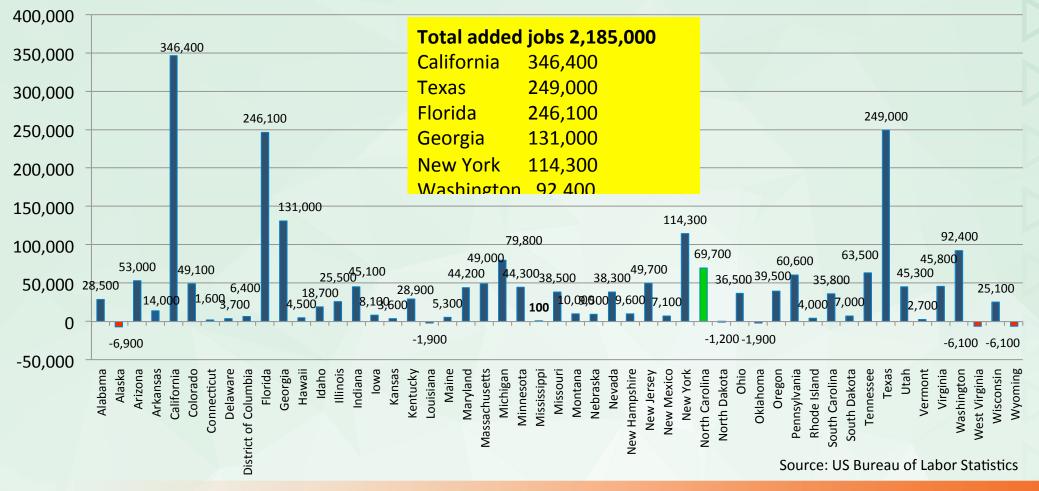

## **Total Nonfarm Employment Change Mar 2016 – Mar 2017**







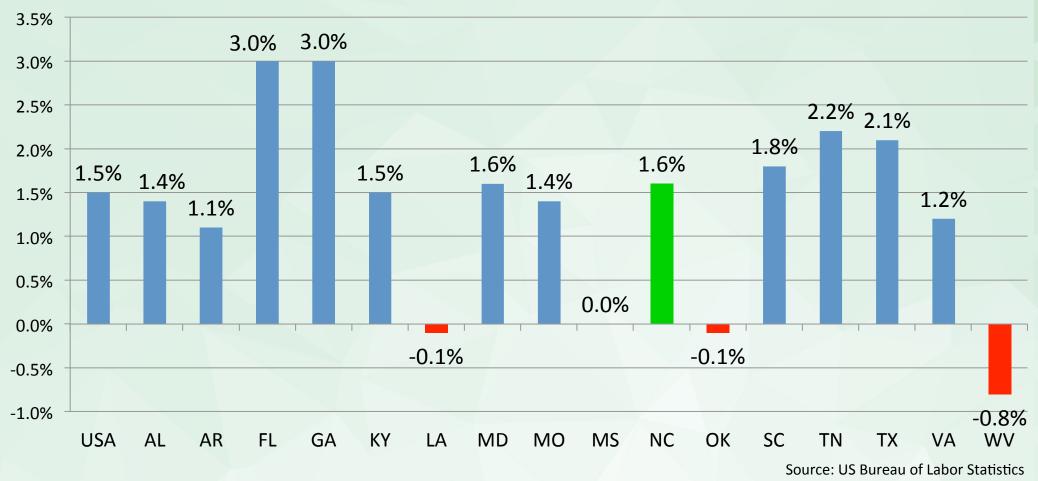

### **% Nonfarm Employment Change Mar 2016 – Mar 2017**





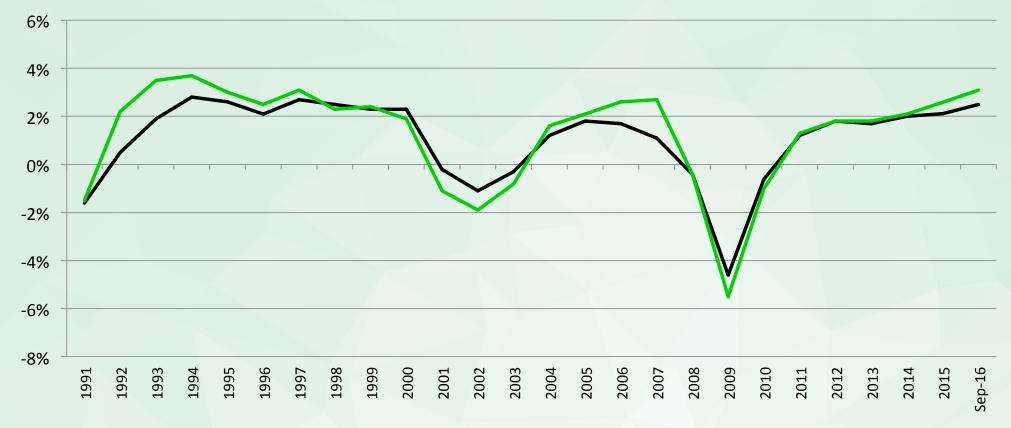




## % Annual Job Change 1990 - Sept 2017

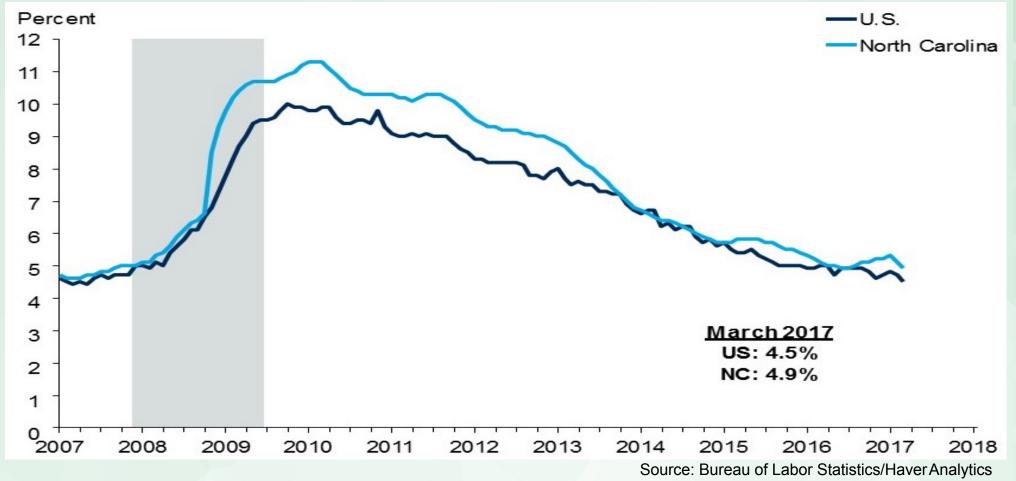

## **NC Unemployment Rate**



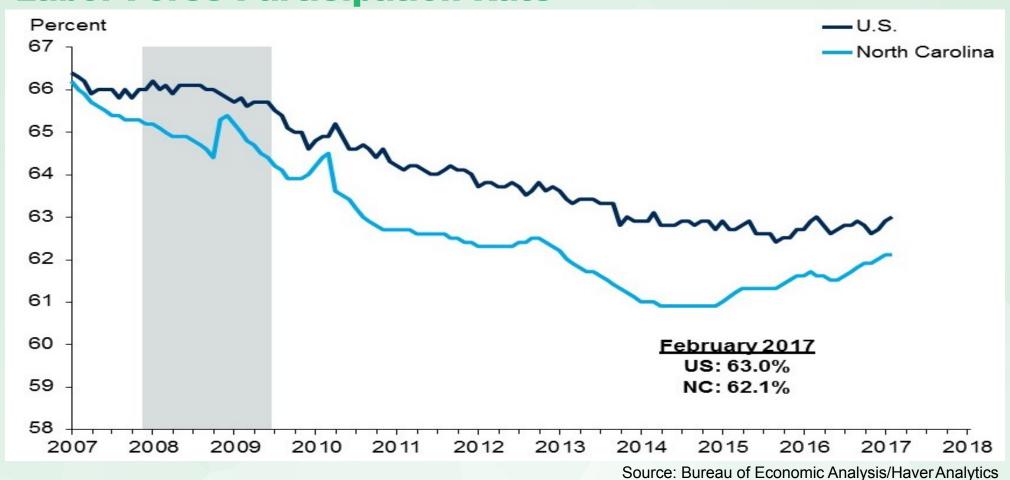




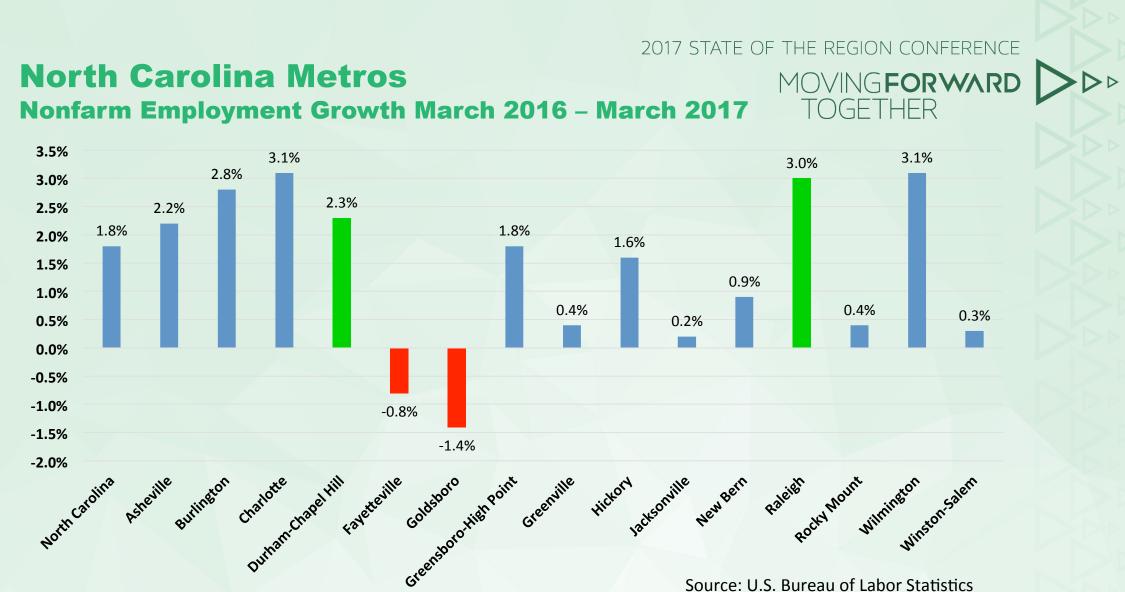

## **Labor Force Participation Rate**







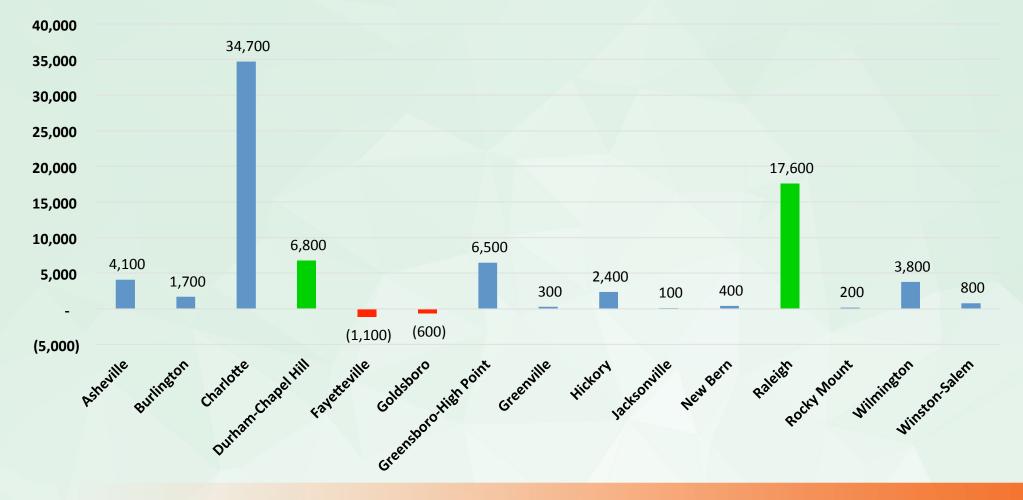

### **Nonfarm Employment Growth March 2016 – March 2017**







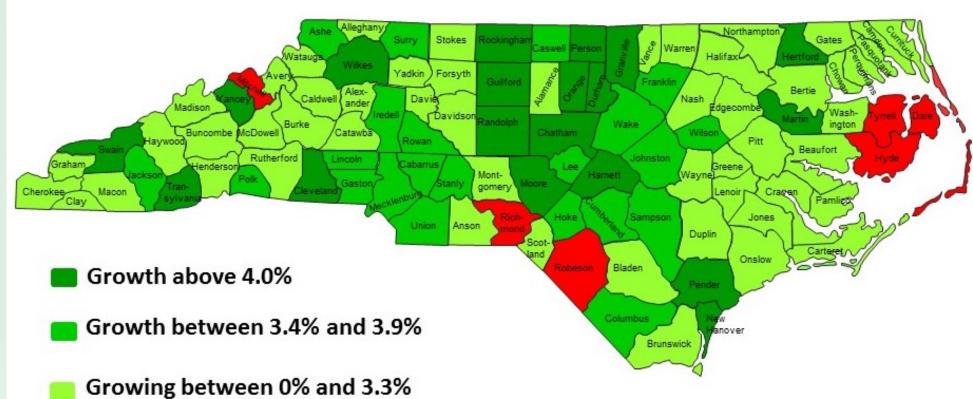

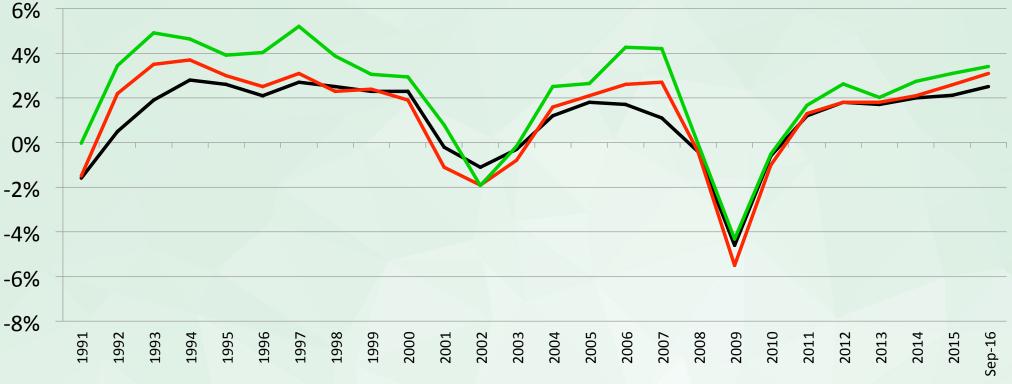

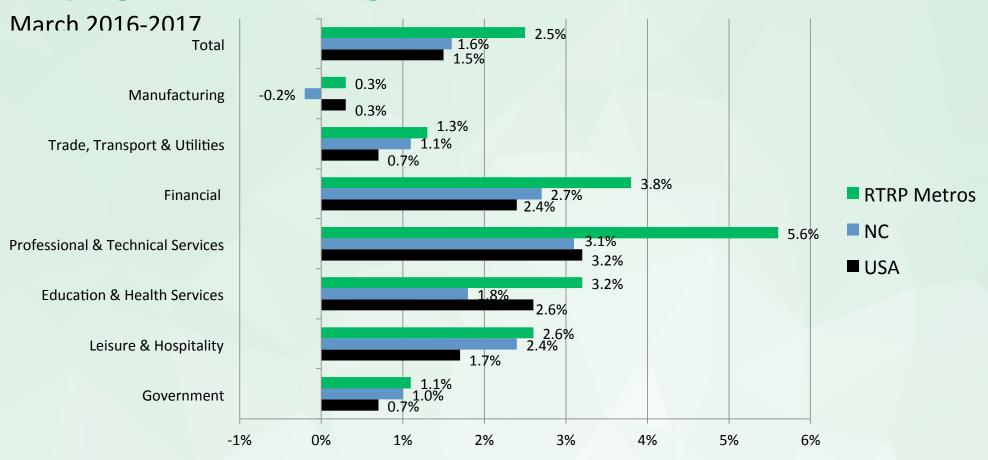

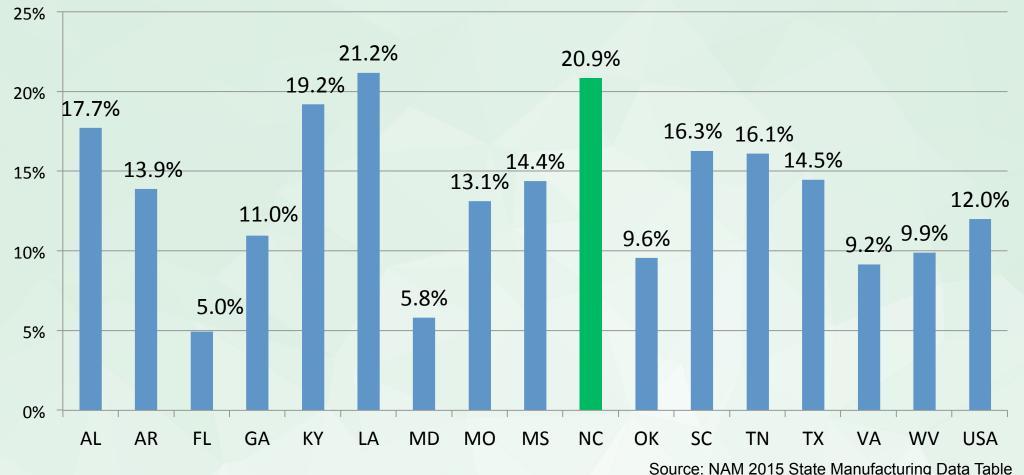


## **Southern States Manufacturing Share of GSP**

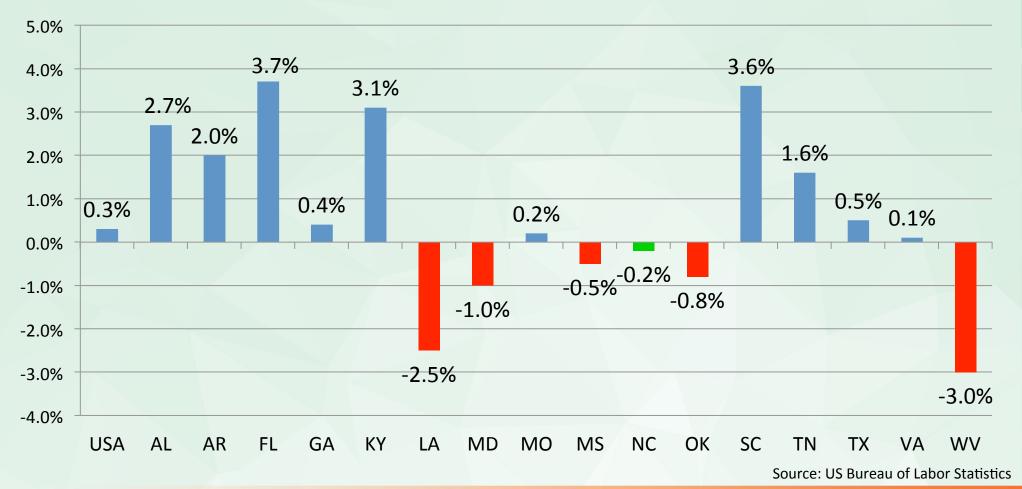

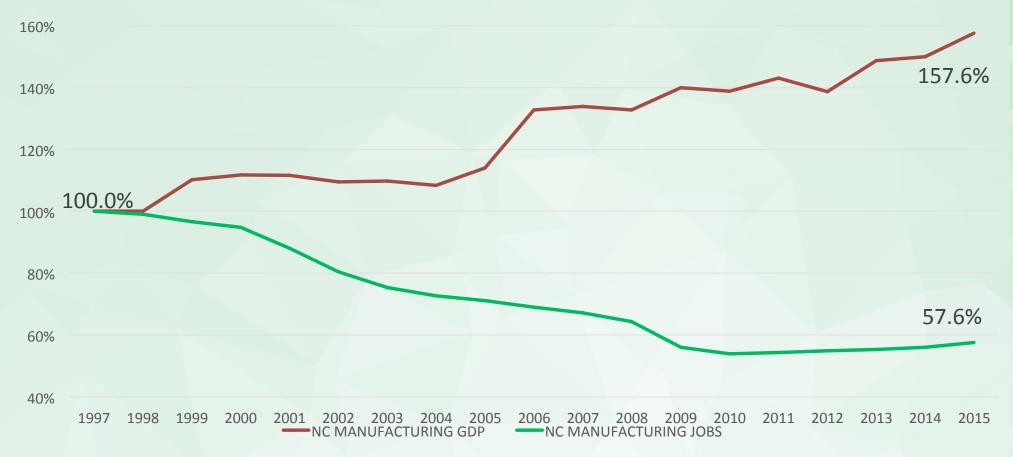

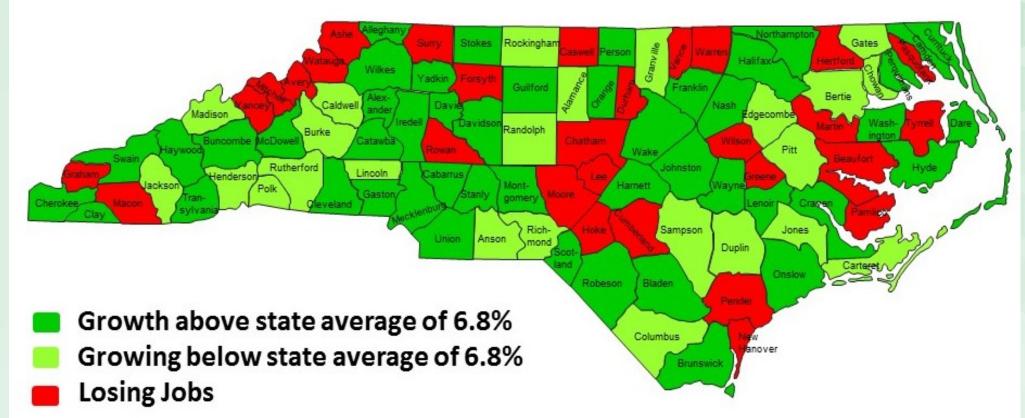


# **Change in Manufacturing Jobs Five Years** 2011 - 2016

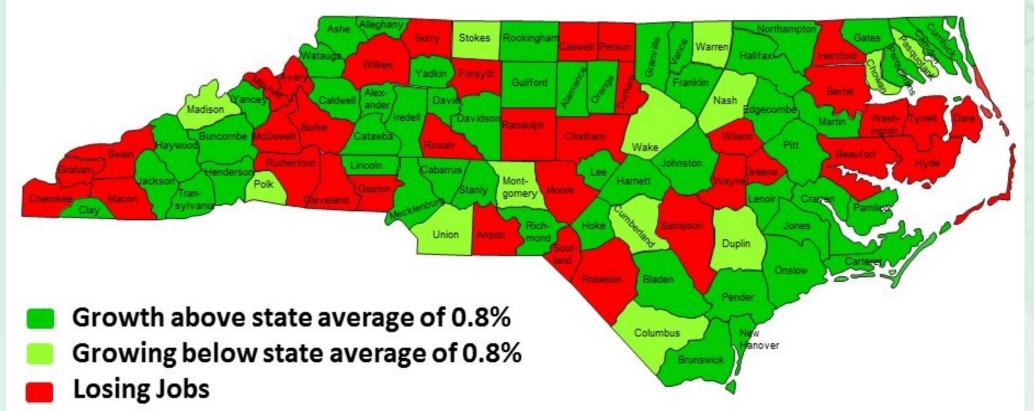


# **Change in Manufacturing Jobs One Year** 2015 - 2016

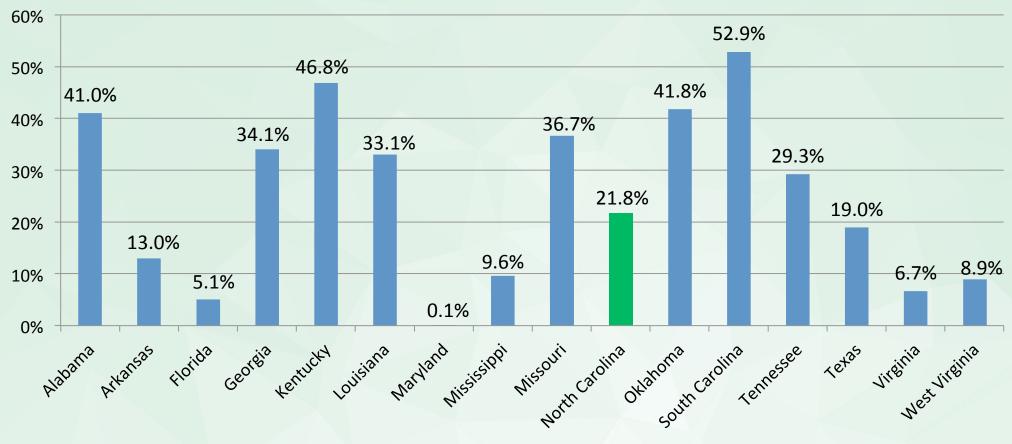

# **Change in Manufactured Exports 2010 - 2015**





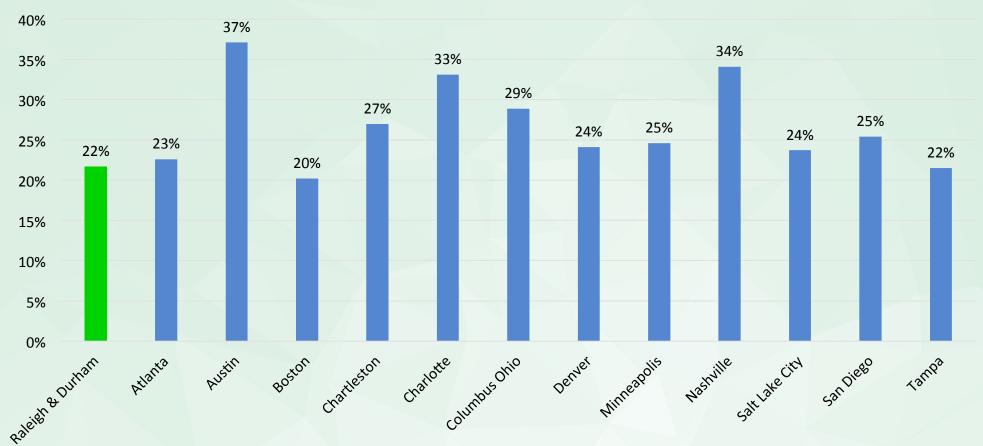

## North Carolina Metros Growth in GDP 2010 - 2015



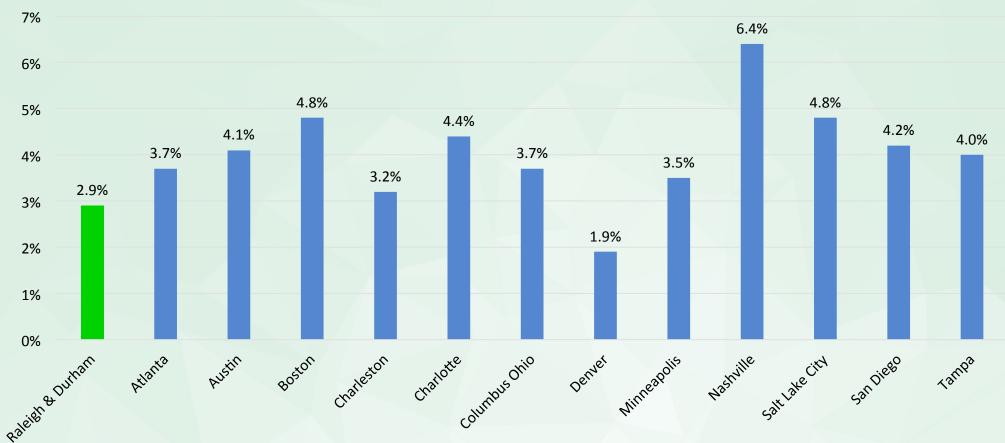


# % Growth in Personal Income 2014 - 2015







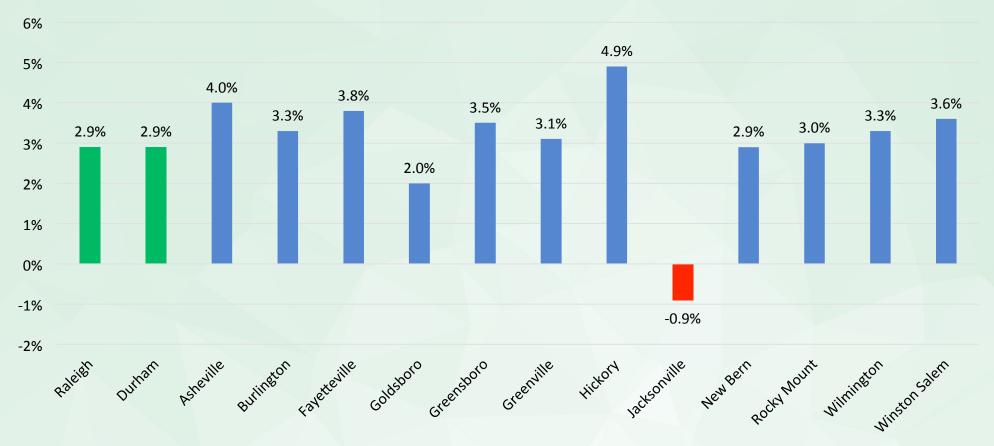

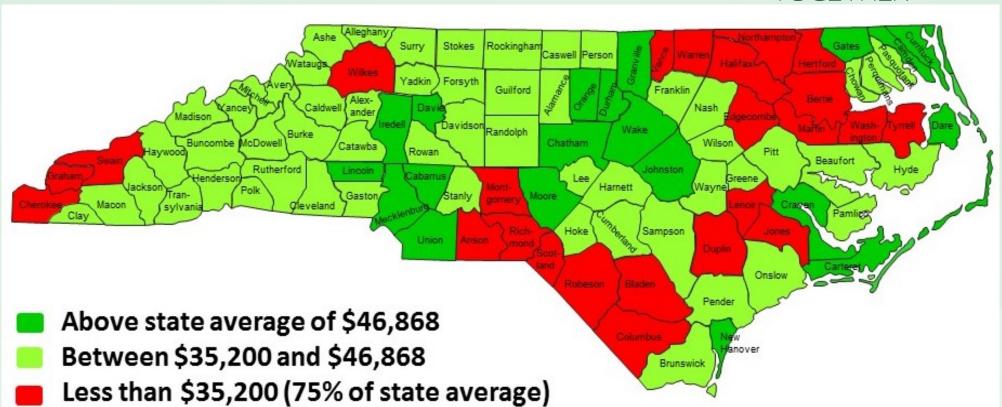

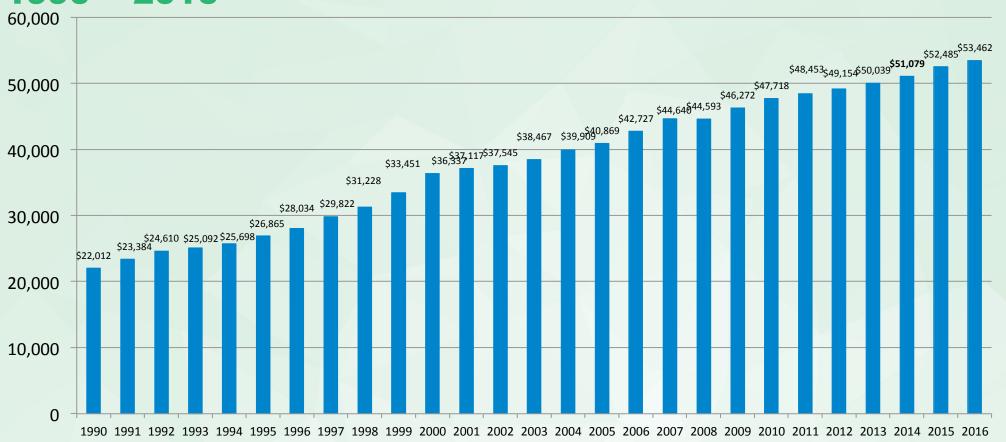

# RTRP Average Annual Wage Growth Adjusted for Inflation 1990 - 2016

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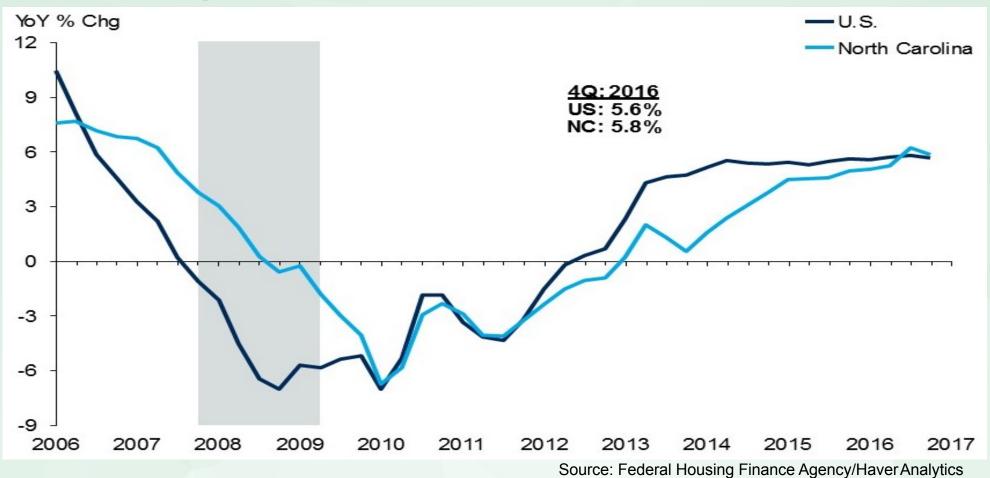

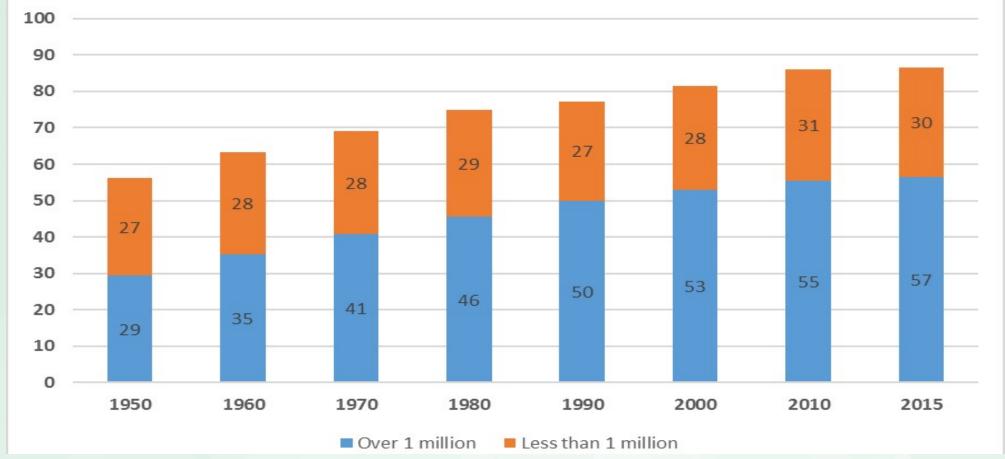

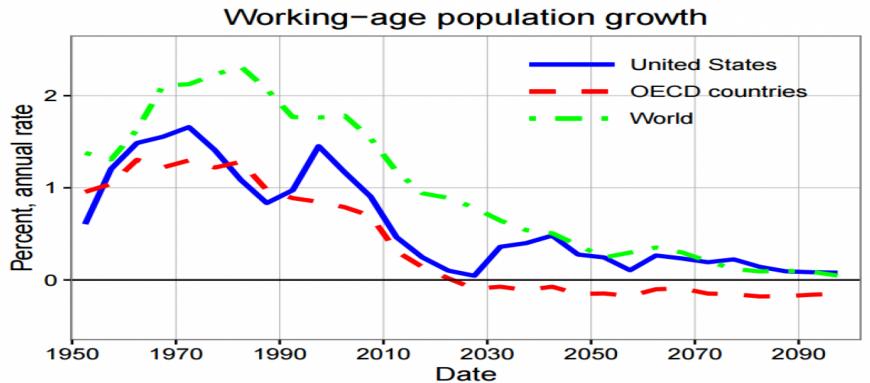


## **The Slowing of Global Population Growth**



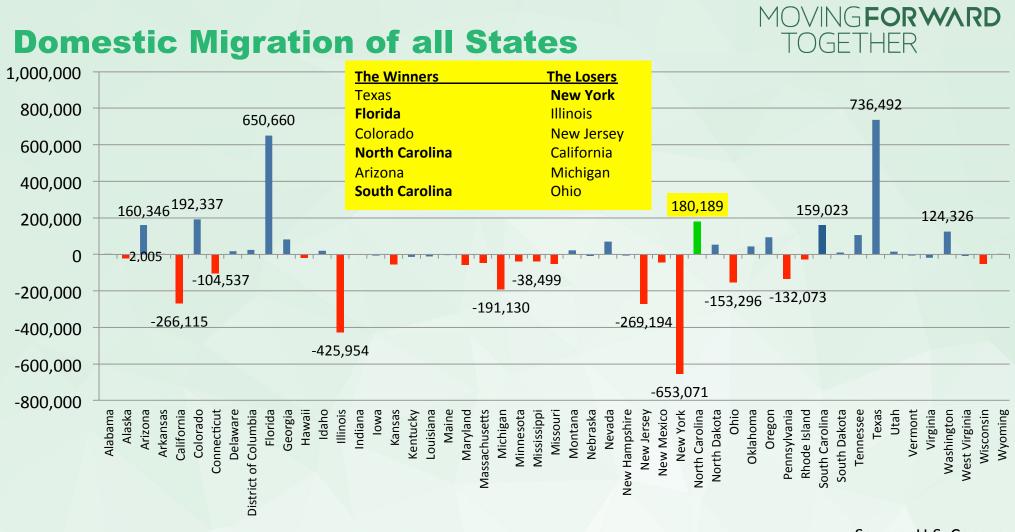

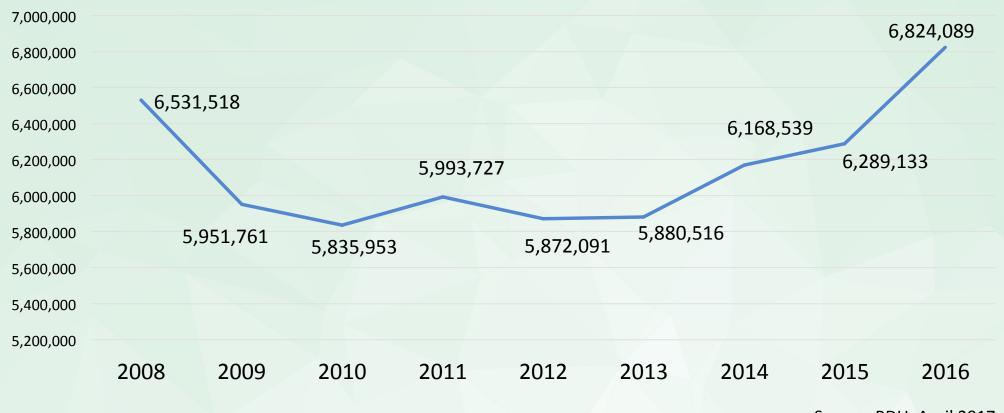

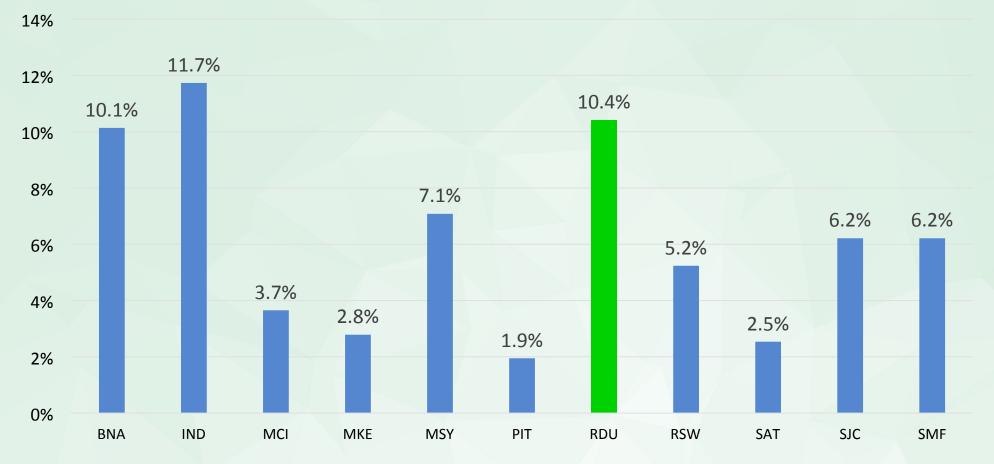


### **Enplanement Growth** 2015 - 2016
